

CRITERIA FOR ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

Academic Honours – recognition of student academic achievement

- Must have 3.8 GPA or higher
- Appears on transcript and parchment

Program Achievement Award – recognition of a student’s academic excellence within their program of study

- Recognition of Academic Excellence in Program of Study
- Must have 3.8 GPA or higher
- Must be a graduating student from a one, two or three year program

Coordinators and faculty nominate and select Program Achievement Award winner.

Board of Governors’ Award- Program Area Achievement Award – recognition of a student’s academic excellence within the Program Area cluster

- Recipient must be chosen from pool of Program Achievement Award winners
- Must have a 3.8 GPA or higher
- Must be a graduating student from a one, two or three year program

Coordinators and faculty review Program Achievement Award winners and select Program Area Achievement Award winner

Governor General’s Award - [Award Information](#)

- Recipient must be chosen from pool of Academic Achievement Award (Program Area) winners
- **Must have 4.0 GPA**
- Must be graduating from a **two or three year program**

Other criteria for consideration:

- Based on academic excellence
- Amount of work done by candidate in program
- Documentation to support the candidate
- Leadership abilities
- Letters of recommendation from faculty
- Involvement and commitment to one’s Educational Institution and Community
- Relative difficulty of outcomes on a program-by-program basis

Award winner selected by Deans and Program Coordinators

President’s Award - The President’s Award recognizes one graduating student each academic year for excellence in student leadership and contribution to the community and College.

- Student must apply for this award
- Must have 3.8 GPA or higher
- Also considers extracurricular activities the student is involved in within the community and the College
- A letter of reference from a faculty member is also required

Award winner selected by Deans and Program Coordinators
