Dual Credits: two high school credits and two college courses

Tools and Equipment I – TSK4T (College Course: BTT021)

This is an introductory course which will introduce students to a variety of commonly used portable hand and power tools and selected stationary power tools. The emphasis will be on the identification, selection, safe and efficient use and maintenance of these tools. Knowing how to choose the proper tool, how to use it safely and skillfully and how to maintain the tool in good working condition is essential to anyone wishing to work in the building trades.

Tools and Equipment II - TSR4T (College Course: BTT022)

This course builds on Tools and Equipment I. Students' knowledge and practical skill application will be further extended.

Note:

- Tuition, materials, equipment and transportation fees will be covered through the Dual Credit program.
- All students are expected to attend an orientation session prior to taking part in any Dual Credit program.
- Students will be contacted by the SCWI Program Assistant, at least one week prior to the start of the program, to be provided with a date, time and location for each orientation session.
- Delivery: Afternoon or morning release for one semester.
- Students involved in the Dual Credit program will be excused from their regular classes or co-op to attend the College.
