## October Highlights

## Report Card & Parent-Teacher Interviews

With the month of November comes the end of TERM 1. On November 17<sup>th</sup>, the Term 1 report card will be published on the MOZAIK PARENT-PORTAL. For the first time, this also includes report cards for K4 and K5. As a reminder, The first term is worth 20% of the school year (Term 2 is 20% and Term 3 is worth 60%).

We encourage you to sit with your child to look over the report together and take the opportunity to praise all their hard work and effort, as well as acknowledge the areas of improvement and embrace new challenges.

Parent-Teacher Interviews will take place on November 22<sup>nd</sup> (from 3:00-9:00 pm) and on November 23<sup>rd</sup> (from 1:00-7:00 pm). All parents are invited to meet their child's teacher(s) at a pre-scheduled appointment during these days. We will organize the scheduling of appointments using Microsoft Bookings, as we did last year. The booking system will open on Sunday, November 12<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm to give everyone enough time to book an appointment time that's convenient for all. All the pertinent information you need will be sent home in a separate email in the coming weeks.

## Individual Education Plans (IEPs)

A message for parents of students who have an IEP - The revised document will be sent home with your child on November 17<sup>th</sup> (the same day report cards are published) to be signed and returned to the school. There will be two (2) copies – one for you to keep. During the Parent-Teacher Interviews, you will have the opportunity to receive feedback about the current plan as we begin Term 2. Remember, the IEP is a living document and although you do not yet have a hard copy, rest assured that the teacher is implementing accomodations as outlined in the most previous version or according to any new professional recommendations, making revisions as necessary.


