First Day of School (August 30th)

Regular Entry (Grade 1-6)

7:47-7:55

Students may enter the school yard as of 7:47 (via Hudson Ave. Gate next to parking lot)

*After 8:00 am, students are considered late and must enter the building through the main entrance and get a late slip from the office before going to class

Kindergarten & Pre-Kindergarten

K4 and K5 students will enter the building through the main entrance according to the <u>Progressive Entry Schedule</u> where they will be greeted by our Pre-school team. *New parent breakfast offered by Home & School at 8h30. More info to follow

*On Wednesday, August 30th for that first day of school, your child will be able to find their friends and previous year's teachers before discovering who their homeroom teacher will be for the 2023-2024 school year.
