

First Day of School (August 29th)

The first day of classes for students in Grades 1-6 is Thursday, August 29th Edinburgh's Kindergarten and Pre-Kindergarten students will start the year following a progressive entry (click here for more information*)

* When the second bell rings at 7h55, students should already be present in the school yard. After this time, they are considered late and must enter through the main office to get a late slip

Kindergarten & Pre-Kindergarten K4 and K5 students will enter the building through the main entrance according to the <u>Progressive Entry Schedule</u> where they will be greeted by our Pre-school team.

*On Thursday, August 29th for that first day of school, your child will join their friends and previous year's teachers before discovering who their homeroom teacher will be for the 2024-2025 school year. As usual, parents will not be permitted in the yard so make sure to get all your best photos before they go inside the gate! Rest assured that the entire Edinburgh team will be present outside during the festivities to help them find out where to go.

Please be reminded that they must be dressed according to the **Edinburgh Dress**Code and that they should have all their school supplies on their first day.


