Request for Bussing (2024-2025)

Last week, the EMSB sent an email for families of students who require transportation services for the 2024-2025 school year. In case you missed it, June 21st is the deadline to complete their form to ensure that you receive your bus pass on time before the school year starts. Requests that will be received after the deadline will only be processed in October and you child will not be able to take the bus before then.

If you are eligible for transportation services and have not filled it out yet, you have until Friday. Check your email, there is a form that should have been sent you to complete for each child on June 10th, with a reminder sent on June 17th.
