Statement of Accounts: April 2023 – New statements were sent out

- Statement of accounts for April were sent out
- Payments are due Wednesdays May 10, 2023
- Please note that when changes are made to your child(ren)'s reservation of days and the week has begun. The change will only be reflected once the cycle of the week has been completed.

Pedagogical days

- Changes should also be communicating in writing or by phone. It is preferred that messages are not done through verbal communications by your child.
