## <u>HopHop</u>

#### Changes in schedule:

- if your child(ren) will not be attending BASE on a given day, as per their regular schedule, parents are asked to advise **both** the school (514-486-0981) and BASE (514-788-0024);
- please communicate any last-minute / same-day changes (to both the school and to BASE) **no later than 13:30** so that all relevant parties (i.e. child(ren) and adults) can be duly informed.

#### Morning Drop off/Afternoon Pickup:

Parents are asked to:

- **not congregate in the entrance way**, including on the path leading from the sidewalk to the gate while waiting for your child(ren);
- refrain from having children play and/or assemble in groups in that area.
- **depart promptly** from the entrance and pathway once your child(ren) have been collected from the daycare;
  - those who remain around the entrance and pathway prevent daycare staff from identifying who has been picked up and who is still waiting.
- Safety of the children arriving and leaving BASE is all our responsibility please be vigilant of the students arriving and leaving BASE. It is imperative that the rules of the road are followed for their safety. Please drive slowly and respect school zone speed.
