

Morning Drop off/Afternoon Pickup:

Parents are asked to:

- o refrain from having children play and/or assemble in groups in that area.
- o **depart promptly** from the entrance and pathway once your child(ren) have been collected from the daycare;

- o those who remain around the entrance and pathway prevent daycare staff from identifying who has been picked up and who is still waiting.
- o Safety of the children arriving and leaving BASE is all our responsibility please be vigilant of the students arriving and leaving BASE. It is imperative that the rules of the road are followed for their safety. Please drive slowly and respect school zone speed.
