1. <u>Meet the Staff/General Assembly/Curriculum Night: Thursday, September 21st, 2023.</u>

Please mark <u>Thursday</u>, <u>September 21st</u>, <u>2023</u>, on your calendar. This evening has been planned for parents to come join us for the General Assembly starting at 6:15 p.m. An In-Person curriculum night will be offered to all our parents. <u>Parents are requested to leave</u> their child(ren) at home as this is an evening for <u>parents only</u>. There will not be any supervision for the children. We are looking forward to seeing you in attendance, as it is an important evening concerning your child's education and to ensure a Governing Board.

2. General Assembly and Governing Board

A General Assembly for all the Carlyle parents/guardians will be held on <u>Thursday</u>, <u>September 21st</u> in the gymnasium <u>between 6:15p.m. and 7: 30 p.m.</u> During this time, you will get to meet the entire Carlyle Team serving on the Governing Board and participate in the General Assembly. We will be providing light snacks and refreshments. A separate memo will follow and will outline the details of the General Assembly.

3. <u>Welcome Back Celebration: Thursday, September 14^h, 2023</u>

On <u>Thursday</u>, <u>September 14th</u>, the Carlyle staff is excited to host its annual Welcome Back Celebration! This will be a day for all our students to enjoy the fun-filled activities organized by our dynamic staff! 4. Friday, September 29th: Student Attestation Day

Every year, on the last school day in September, we are asked by the Ministry to provide proof of the attendance and presence of each student at Carlyle School. This will be done by means of a group attestation signed by the teacher and the principal. It is based on the enrolment of this day that the school board and the schools are allocated government funds for the entire year. *Please make every effort to have your child present in school on Thursday, September 30th.*

5. Our Hot Lunch Service Provider for 2023-2024 is TRAITEUR MERENDA

The Governing Board once again approved **Merenda** to be our hot lunch provider for the 2023-2024 school year! We would like to take this opportunity to inform you that they will be offering meal

choices every day, at the cost of <u>\$6.25</u> per regular format meal. Take advantage of the fresh and delicious hot lunches made available for your child to enjoy daily! **The program will commence Monday, September 11th**.

6. Bus Transportation

7. Arriving to School on Time

Parents are reminded to have their child(ren) arrive at school at 9:05 a.m. and/or before the 9:15a.m. bell. Too many children are arriving after 9:15a.m. A few minutes may not seem important, but they are truly important for your child's ability to be organized for the day. The homeroom period, from 9:15 a.m. - 9:20a.m., is used for organizing their books, submitting anything that is due and preparing for their day. Children arriving late feel uncomfortable and must then use instruction time for all the organizational tasks. Consider the significance of a loss of 10 minutes of instruction each day = 50 minutes a week, over 3 hours each month, over 33 hours per year or almost 7 lost days at the end of a year. We ask for your cooperation in helping us ensure that your child is properly organized and ready.

8. Change of Dismissal Routine

A reminder to parents that any <u>change in the departure routine of your child(ren) must be written</u> <u>in the school agenda.</u> If you need to notify the school via telephone call, <u>please note</u>, <u>there will be</u> <u>no changes accepted after 1:30 p.m. Please do not send an email to the teacher or the secretary</u> <u>after this time</u>, <u>as they may not see the message in time for the change to be made (page 6 in</u> <u>the agenda book)</u>. If you are picking up your child, please be punctual as there is no one to supervise your child at the office past 4:05p.m. The end of the day is a very busy time at Carlyle and we ask all parents for their cooperation in order for dismissal to run smoothly.

9. <u>School Agenda</u>

Please take the time to read the information inside the agenda book with your child. Once you have read the agenda book with your child, **please sign page 1 and page 12**. Any lost agendas will be replaced at a cost of \$10.00. For your information, the agenda is also posted on our website for your viewing.

10. <u>Breakfast</u>

The Breakfast Program of Canada will start at Carlyle on <u>Monday</u>, <u>September 18th</u>. You have received the form for registration and a donation is greatly appreciated. <u>Any donation amount is generous</u> <u>and will be supporting children</u>.

11. <u>B.A.S.E Daycare</u>

• The B.A.S.E. Daycare service is offered to all the students who are registered at the school. The hours of operation are from: 7:15a.m. - 8:45a.m. and 3:55p.m. - 6:00p.m. (Pre-Kindergarten to

Grade 6 are dismissed at 3:55p.m.). This program allows the children to have outdoor play, snacks with peers, time for homework as well as time to participate in group activities. Daycare provides the children with the opportunity to start their homework, as this is an important part of their daily schedule. Please note that the school rules also apply to the Daycare Program.

<u>Please keep in mind that you must register your child as a regular daycare user or as a sporadic</u> <u>user (occasional).</u> The cost for daycare services is \$9.20/day for three or more days. Sporadic users (occasional users - less than three days per week) will be charged \$12.00/day.

Important notice: if you have not yet paid lunch supervision fees please do so online. contact <u>Priscilla Gervasi (514 788-0021)</u> for your reference number.

The Ministère de l'Éducation, Enseignement Supérieur et Recherche (MEESR), has increased the Daycare fees for regular users by the consumer price index (Quebec) effective July 1, 2023. The regular daycare fee has increased from \$8.95 to \$9.20 per day for students who are registered on a regular basis at any of the EMSB government-subsidized daycares.

The Definition for Regular Students has been modified to include students who are registered and attend daycare on a fixed schedule for one or two days.

The Daycare fee structure is based on the student's status in daycare. A student's status is designated as Regular, Sporadic or Occasional. Please refer to the tables below.

REGULAR DAYCARE STATUS

DEFINITION: A regular student is one who is registered and attending Daycare for <mark>a minimum of 1 to 5 days a week and a minimum of 2 periods per day</mark> * This applies to students who attend on a weekly basis.

	3 days/week:	Lunch fees are <u>included</u> in the \$9.20/day for a regular student attending for 3 days. If the student attends only at lunchtime on the 4 th and 5 th days, then <u>lunch fees must be paid for the 4th and 5th day.</u>	

day	C ve /week:	Lunch fees are <u>included</u> in the \$9.20/day for a regular student attending for 2 days. If the student attends only at lunchtime on the 3 rd , 4 ^{th,} and 5 th day, then <u>lunch fees must be paid for the 3rd,4th and 5th day.</u>
day	1 y/week:	Lunch fees are <u>included</u> in the \$9.20/day for a regular student attending for 1 day. If the student attends only at lunchtime on the 2 nd , 3 rd , 4 ^{th,} and 5 th day, then <u>lunch fees must be paid for the 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th day.</u>
