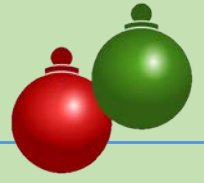

CTV Spirit of Giving Campaign

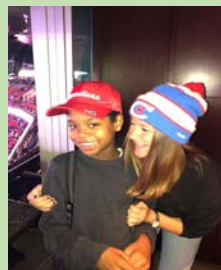
