Supplies List – Grade 1

2020-2021

Please make sure to clearly label all your child's supplies!

1. One (1) school bag (big enough to put all books, including library books)
2. One (1) lunch box, labeled
3. Two (2) packs of 24 HB pencils (good-quality & sharpened) – label each pencil
4. Two (2) material pencil cases with two compartments each (*No plastic or metal pencil cases*)
5. One (1) box of wax crayons
6. Two (2) highlighters (*yellow; red*)
7. Two (2) black sharpies (*fine tip*)
8. One (1) box of coloring pencils sharpened in a pencil case (*no more than 24*)
9. One (1) box of non-toxic markers (*no more than 24*)
10. Five (5) white erasers, labeled
11. Three (3) large glue sticks (*no liquid glue; no colored glue*)
12. One (1) pair of sturdy, good quality safety (i.e. children's) scissors
13. One (1) clear, slide-lock binder pouch (*with three fasteners*)
14. One (1) smock, labeled with child's name clearly visible
15. Two (2) good-quality pencil sharpeners
16. Two (2) scrapbooks (35.5cm x 27.9cm)
17. One (1) package of construction paper (*10 colors*)

OPTIONAL:

18. One (1) box of facial tissues

JUST A FEW REMINDERS:

- ✓ please label each item with your child's name (except for plastic bags and box of tissue)
- ✓ please send these supplies with your child on the first day of school
- ✓ grade one students line up in the school yard and then enter the school on the junior side by themselves (except for the first day of school, when students are to line up in the gymnasium with a parent)
- ✓ grade one students are responsible for dressing themselves and putting away their own school bags and lunch boxes
- ✓ on the first day of school, please include a note with your child's belongings that states where they are going after the school day is over:
 - A. school bus (indicate the school bus number)
 - B. home (pick up by parent or guardian)
 - C. PSA

Please advise the school if/when changes occur to your child's after-school routine.
