

# Mackay-Layton school breaks ground



On November 2, officials from the English Montreal School Board and the incoming Mackay Centre-Philip E. Layton School officially broke ground in the field at the corner of the Terrebonne St. and Benny Ave. Long used as soccer fields, the terrain will be converted into a state-of-the-art facility for disabled English-language students. The 9,000 square-metre school, slated for completion by the summer of 2018, will house 200 students.
