Nature of the work

The education consultant participates in carrying out the educational project and the special projects of educational institutions; he or she participates in the development, implementation and evaluation of their success plan, while complying with the academic and administrative requirements of both the educational institutions and the school board.

Tasks and responsibilities

- He or she contributes to the implementation of programs of study and training by working with teachers to prepare and implement strategies and projects aimed at helping students who are experiencing or who are likely to experience social maladjustments or learning difficulties.
- He or she supports the teachers and administration concerning the interpretation of those programs, either individually or in a group format in matters pertaining to their daily teaching activities.
- He or she designs and leads training workshops and sessions on program components and collaborates in developing learning situations and supports experimentation in class.
- He or she provides teachers with learning evaluation tools and guides them in the design, preparation or adaptation of evaluation tools.
- He or she may be called upon to work with a multidisciplinary team to draw up and review the individualized education plan of a handicapped student or a student with social maladjustments or learning difficulties.
- He or she advises management, teaching or professional staff on matters pertaining to professional development programs, plans the programs and evaluates the results.
