#### Nature of the Work

The education consultant participates in carrying out the educational project and the special projects of educational institutions; they participate in the development, implementation, and evaluation of their success plan, while complying with the academic and administrative requirements of both the educational institutions and the school board.

#### Tasks and responsibilities

- Develops adaptive approaches/strategies, works one on one to enable student to be successful in all subject areas in collaboration with teachers and professionals within other departments.
- Facilitates the integration of one or more students with complex cases of ASD with severe behavior difficulties
  into the regular sector or self-contained classes if need be and monitor, where possible, their academic
  progress and organize professional development workshops for the teaching, administrative and professional
  personnel.
- Communicates to schools the special education resource network (liaison with the Health and Social Services Sector) available and facilitates the integration of identified special education students within their community school.
- Assumes a leadership role with school administrators, teaching personnel and parents with respect to the principles, procedures, roles, and responsibilities regarding the individualized education plan (IEP).

### Requirements and Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree as well as a certificate, diploma or graduate degree in the field of special education or in a related field
- Strong knowledge and relevant teaching experience (preferably a minimum of (5) years in the field of ASD complex cases and severe behaviour difficulties would be an asset)
- Ability to be a dedicated and conscientious individual who can function well under pressure as well as have the ability to work effectively both independently and as a member of a team
- Excellent language skills, both oral and written
- Strong communication, organizational, analytical, interpersonal, conflict resolution and leadership skills
