Tasks and responsibilities

- Contributes to the implementation of programs of study and training, provides advice to the teachers and
 administration concerning the interpretation of those programs, designs, and leads training workshops and sessions
 on program components; they collaborate in developing learning situations and support experimentation in class.
- Provides advice and support to teachers either individually or in a group format in matters pertaining to their daily teaching activities; they develop or select and deliver training and instrumentation activities designed to respond to needs in pedagogical adaptation, innovation, and development. They provide teachers with learning evaluation tools and guide them in the design, preparation, or adaptation of evaluation tools.

 intervention objectives and means.
