Nature of the Work

The Board will be operating its 2024 Summer School Program at the secondary level, offering junior and senior courses in July 2024. The courses will be taught to the students while physically present at John F. Kennedy High School (Secondary 1 math transition and secondary 4 - 5), and at home by teachers using distance education platforms (Secondary 1 - 3).

The Board is seeking to hire qualified teachers for the summer session. Candidates will be required to attend a compulsory general information meeting to take place in person before the start of classes (date to be determined).

Teachers may be released at any time during the first three (3) days of Summer School. Under the supervision of the Administration of Summer School, the teaching personnel will follow the methods of instruction corresponding to the requirements and objectives set for each subject domain as well as evaluate the progress of students so as to examine and assess continually and periodically the needs and achievement of objectives of every student.

Requirements and Qualifications

- Valid teaching license as issued by the Ministère (MEQ)
- Availability to work in school (Secondary 1 math transition and Sec. 4 & 5)
- Comfortable using TEAMS for video-conference (Sec. 1 3)
- Comfortable with ongoing evaluation as there will not be final exams in Secondary I III courses as well as language courses in secondary 4
- Excellent knowledge of the language of instruction (oral and written)
- Knowledge, experience and interest in the high school curriculum programs offered at the Summer School sessions
- Excellent communication skills, organizational, problem-solving and multi-tasking abilities
- Proven abilities to work within a team structure


