## PURPOSE

To provide procedures for the supply of nutritional supplements to inner city elementary schools.

## GENERAL

All inner city elementary schools shall benefit from one of the following programs:

- 1. Breakfast Program
- 2. Snack Program
- 3. Soup Program
- 4. Cafeteria Subsidy
- 5. Special Nutritional Education Projects

## PROCEDURES

- 1. The inner city schools shall be determined by the Island Council's<sup>\*</sup> inner city index and the Board.
- 2. The amount of money allocated to each school shall be determined in cooperation with the Board's inner city school consultant.
- 3. An action plan for the current year shall be submitted to the Island Council\* by October 30<sup>th</sup>.

- 4. The ordering and distribution of food shall be coordinated by the Cafeteria Services Department.
- 5. All inner city schools taking part in the program shall send the signed delivery slips to Cafeteria Services upon receipt of the goods.
- 6. The schools shall inform Cafeteria Services of any food allergies that students may have.
- 7. The schools shall inform Cafeteria Services of any delivery problems.
- 8. A summary report of the activities and programs shall be prepared by the Nutrition Education Dietitian, a copy of which shall be sent to the Island Council<sup>\*</sup> by October 30<sup>th</sup> of the following school year.
