## PURPOSE

To provide procedures for the supply of nutritional supplements to inner city elementary schools.

## GENERAL

All inner city elementary schools shall benefit from one of the following programs:

1. Breakfast Program
2. Snack Program
3. Soup Program
4. Cafeteria Subsidy
5. Special Nutritional Education Projects

## PROCEDURES

1. The inner city schools shall be determined by the Island Council's\* inner city index and the Board.
2. The amount of money allocated to each school shall be determined in cooperation with the Board's inner city school consultant.
3. An action plan for the current year shall be submitted to the Island Council\* by October 30<sup>th</sup>.

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4. The ordering and distribution of food shall be coordinated by the Cafeteria Services Department.
5. All inner city schools taking part in the program shall send the signed delivery slips to Cafeteria Services upon receipt of the goods.
6. The schools shall inform Cafeteria Services of any food allergies that students may have.
7. The schools shall inform Cafeteria Services of any delivery problems.
8. A summary report of the activities and programs shall be prepared by the Nutrition Education Dietitian, a copy of which shall be sent to the Island Council\* by October 30<sup>th</sup> of the following school year.

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
