# Transition to High School for Grade 6 students and parents

In the month of February, we are pleased to announce that our 6E students will be offered 8 in-class sessions to start their transition to High School. This activity-based program addresses transition anxiety, specific strategies for high school level study and test taking, and how to apply them for academic success. Skills acquired include high school class organization techniques, note-taking, preventing plagiarism, project planning, test preparation, and social skills to help with the big transition. An evening parent (and child) workshop will be held virtually on February 28<sup>th</sup>.
