# Key Features of Essential Knowledge of the Three Musical Competencies

#### ✓ <u>To interpret musical pieces</u>

- To become familiar with the musical content of the piece(s) (musical language, structure and graphic representation of pitch, duration, intensity and form)
- To apply elements of technique (posture, holding position, sound production, intonation, fingerings) as well as care and maintenance of the instrument.
- To bring out the expressive elements of the piece
- To apply the rules for group ensemble work
- To share his/her interpretation experience

### ✓ <u>To invent instrumental pieces</u>

- To use ideas inspired by a stimulus for creation
- To use sound sources (instrument) and elements of musical language and technique
- To organize the elements the student has chosen
- To finalize a production
- To share the student's creative experience

### ✓ <u>To appreciate musical works</u>

- To examine a musical work or excerpt for elements of content
- To examine a musical work or excerpt for socio-cultural references
- To make connections between what the student has felt and examined
- To make a critical or aesthetic judgment

• To share their appreciation experience
