Program Content

✓ Key Features of Competency Performs musical works

- Becomes familiar with the musical content of the work (musical language, structure and the graphic representation : pitch, duration, intensity, form)
- Applies elements of instrumental technique (care and maintenance of instrument, posture, holding position, breathing, tone production, intonation, tonguing, fingering, majors and minors scales, arpeggios, chromatic scale)
- Becomes familiar with the expressive nature of the piece of music (tempo, style, dynamics, phrasing and tonguing)
- Respects the conventions regarding group ensemble work (follows the leader's indications and listens to others)
- Shares his/her musical performance experience

✓ Key Features of Competency Creates musical works

- Uses ideas to create a musical work
- Uses sound sources (instrument), elements of musical language and elements of technique
- Organizes his/her musical creation
- Shares his/her creative musical experience



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✓ Key Features of Competency Appreciates musical works

- Analyzes a work or production
- Interprets the meaning of the work or production
- · Makes a critical and aesthetic judgment
- Shares his/her appreciation experience

Evaluation
