# **Essential knowledges**

#### ✓ Key Features of Competency **To interpret musical pieces**

- To become familiar with the musical content of the piece (musical language, structure and the graphic representation : pitch, duration, intensity, form)
- To apply elements of technique (care and maintenance of instrument, posture, holding position, breathing, tone production, intonation, tonguing, fingering)
- To bring out the expressive elements of the piece
- To share his/her interpretation experience
- To become familiar with the musical content of the piece

#### ✓ Key Features of Competency **To invent instrumental pieces**

- To use personal ideas inspired by the stimulus creation
- To use sources (instrument) and elements of musical language and elements of technique musical et de technique
- To organize the elements he/she has chosen
- To finalise a production
- To share his/her creative experience
