Three emergency daycares available during Spring break for essential workers

Dear parents:

There will be three emergency daycares available during Spring break from (March 1st to 5th inclusively). They are Pierre de Coubertin 4700 Lavoisier, St. Leonard H1R 1T9, John Caboto Academy 8955 Meunier, Ahuntsic H2N 1W3, and Westmount Park (North Campus) 5100 Cote St Luc, Montreal H3W 2G9.

Emergency daycare services are provided under exceptional circumstances to parents who have no other option. Moreover, they are reserved for the children of parents who hold jobs that are on the list of essential services entitling them to emergency daycare services.¹

In accordance with government recommendations for limiting the risks of spreading the virus, these services should only be used by parents who are entitled to them and for whom it is the only option allowing them to report to work. Therefore, families with one parent at home—even if that parent is teleworking—should avoid using these services.

Registration

If you will need to use these services, an online registration form will be available as of February 19th 2021.

Parents are asked to register their children in advance by filling out the online form, but it will be possible to register in-person in the morning. Parents must register each of their children for each day that services are required. Upon your arrival at the emergency school daycare, you will be asked to fill out an information sheet.

No meal services will be offered, and no snacks will be provided. Please send a cold lunch or a hot meal in an insulated container. No other types of lunches are accepted.

Thank you for your ongoing efforts to support your children in this extraordinary context.
