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# 12.2 Principal Report

#### 13.1 Covid related items

 Wanted to know what we can do to help the teachers or students during this time?

Procedures:

Measures recommended have been put in place. PPE in place. Sanitizer not in shortage etc.

• The classes are bigger. Is there a staffing situation? Is the school understaffed?

A few in oversize ..over 20

3 classes grade 4-23, grade 5-25.

Asked board to split classroom, 6-23..21 in class 2 are virtual)

- What is the procedure when a student or staff test positive for COVID-19?
   Document from EMSB Parent is contacted and child to be tested.
   Parent must report with proof document before returning.
   Same for staff member.
- Virtual? Why can't we record class for those that need virtual class?
   Against collective agreement. Class work will be available on-line.
- Would it be possible to check the body temperature of the students when they come in the school?
   Logistics impossible, infra red thermometers
   If student not feeling well, temperature is taken.



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- Does the school have mask for the children that might forget one at home?
   Secured donation from company for masks.
- Would it be possible to invest in glass dividers between desks?
   School board given directives against it based on safety hazard
- When will lockers be available again? (winter is coming) Looking at plan. No decision at this time.
   In discussion, Directives will be sent out in October

## 13.3 PELO

No direction from school board at this time. Usually students are not from same group. Awaiting further instructions from school board.

## 13.5 General

- Last year issues with snow removal and salting. Winter arriving. Need to be on top of that. Meeting contractor in October.
- Has ventilation in the school been checked?
   -Contract issued in mid-September. Work starting in October. Vent cleaning etc.
- Status on water quality at the school
  Was supposed to be checked by June 2020.
  Has been verified...4 sinks were a problem and have been replaced. All drinking water good.



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# 13.5 General (contd)

- Parking lot
  - -The 15 min drop off on Rolland is full of parked cars in the morning.
  - Police have given warnings to parents.
  - -Parents can go in parking lot before 730 and after 3pm.
  - -Is there possibility of student drop off directly at senior yard to alleviate traffic on Maurice Duplessis? No. Safety concerns.
- -Is there possibility of Sports Concentration students entering from the teachers entrance? No. Asper Covid procedures, one entrance is dedicated for the staff.
- Daycare..will they implement the app (HOP?) which informs pick up time so they can get kids ready to avoid line ups outside? To be revisted as was not popular/used last year.
- When will monthly Newsletter be sent out? Memos...monthly calendar
- When will yearbook be available?
   Just received. Will send out notice.
- Will the hot lunch program start? October 13th
- What is update on busing situation? Many parents told to wait until October 1<sup>st</sup>..all accepted already. Those that may still have issues can contact Principal
- When will website be updated? When pressing on minutes link it says unavailable. J
- -Jessica has been working on website. Changes being made currently. Want to regain control of website from school directly.
  - What is status on Open House? How will it be done. Need to attract students to the school.
     Typically in December/January. Virtually met with teachers on how this can be done.



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# 13.6 General (contd)

- STEAM, Robotics?
   Will look into it. Usually brought in through measures at school board.
- Bathroom breaks. Why some classes are only permitted if it's an emergency?
   Schedule adopted for each age group. If they need to go, they are allowed to go.
- Discussion was had on how we would be handling bullying in school. (in class and on the bus)
  - -When bullying occurs, it will be handled on individual basis.
