Supply List: Grade 3

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The following is a list of supplies that your child will need this September in **Grade 3**. We would appreciate it if all the supplies would be brought in by the first day of school so that we can set to work without delay.

1	package of loose leaf sheets (100/pack)
1	plastic pocket folder
8	duo-tangs (1 green, 2 blue, 2 red, 1 orange, 1 yellow, and 1 black (for Phys-Ed)
4	packs of Hilroy copybooks (32 pages). They come in packs of 4 (suggested brand)
1	small pencil case—soft , not hard plastic
3	glue sticks
4	highlighters (yellow, pink, green, blue)
1	pair of scissors
2	blue pens ball point ink
2	red pens ball point ink
2	good quality erasers
1	sharpener
	enough HB pencils for the year
4	dry erase markers
1	transparent plastic centimetre ruler (15 cm)
1	package of good quality pencil crayons (24 per pack)
1	pack of Crayola markers (thick point- 16 per pack) (suggested brand)
1	smock with sleeves (it can be an old shirt)
1	School bag (bags with wheels are not permitted for safety reasons)

We suggest your child keep a box of tissues in his/her locker.

Please ensure that all packaging is removed and that all the items are **individually labelled**. Should your child lose, damage or run out of supplies later on in the year, you will be notified so that the missing items can be promptly replaced. The brands named in the list are our recommendations.
