Laurier Macdonald High School is an inclusive school which caters to all types of learners. Below is an overview of our academic streams. Students who follow an Individualized Education Plan may register for any of the academic streams, provided that they meet the eligibility requirements.

<p>This stream is the required Secondary school program mandated by the Quebec Education Ministry. Students with particular special needs may qualify to enroll in our Resource Program which provides students with a smaller class size in English, French, Math, Social Studies and Science.</p> <p>An Individualized Education Plan is required.</p> <p>Students who graduate from this program may qualify for CEGEP or Vocational Training.</p>	<p>This stream is the required Secondary school program mandated by the Quebec Education Ministry.</p> <p>Students who graduate from this program may qualify for CEGEP or Vocational Training.</p>	<p>Students choosing the Immersion program will receive the majority of their instruction in French.</p> <p>Upon successful completion of the program, they will graduate with more credits than a student in the CORE program and will qualify for CEGEP or Vocational Training.</p> <p>A minimum average of 80% in elementary French as well as successful completion of the entrance exam is required to be admitted into this stream.</p>	<p>The Enriched IB/SÉBIQ stream features the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme. It is intended for students who completed the IBPYP (Primary Years Programme) in Elementary school, for those who are looking for a more rigorous academic profile which will provide students with advanced level courses.</p> <p>Students who graduate from this stream will do so with more credits than their peers, setting them ahead of the competition for CEGEP applications. Furthermore, students in the Enriched Stream get a 2% increase on their R score when applying to SRAM CEGEPs and Marianopolis College.</p> <p>A minimum 75% overall average in elementary as well as successful completion of the entrance exam is required to be admitted into this stream.</p>
