The Preschool Curriculum mandated by the Quebec Ministry of Education (see table below) covers five areas of development (physical and motor development, emotional development, social development, language development and cognitive development). Each area of development is linked to a competency that will be evaluated twice during the school year in English.

Your child's progress will be monitored and evaluated using a variety of assessment tools and strategies. These include classroom observation, participation and student work. Please note that **Google Classroom** will also be used in the event of a school closure and where distance learning is necessary.
