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Leonardo Da Vinci Academy Standards and Procedures Kindergarten School Year 2022-2023

The Preschool Curriculum mandated by the *Ministère de l'Éducation* (see table), is divided into five competencies. This year, there will be 3 terms. In the first report card, competencies 1,3 and 4 will be evaluated. In the second report card, the focus will be on competencies 2,4 and 5. In the last report card, all 5 competencies will be evaluated.

Your child's progress will be monitored and evaluated using a variety of assessment tools and strategies. These include classroom observation, participation, student work, self-assessment, student-teacher conferences, etc.

**Distance Learning	-Kindergarten will be using Google Classroom and video conferencing <u>in the event of class or school closure due to Covid 19.</u>
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A First Communication/Progress Report Card will be issued on **October 13th, 2022** to let you know how your child is adapting to Kindergarten.

Term 1 report cards will be accessible on Mozaik on **November 18th, 2022.**

Term 2 report cards will be accessible on Mozaik on **March 1st, 2023.**

Term 3 report cards will be accessible on Mozaik on **June 23rd, 2023.**

Parent-Teacher Interviews will take place with all parents on **November 24th, 2022** and by invitation only on **March 2nd, 2023.**

In the Kindergarten report card, competencies are graded as A,B,C,D. Please see below what each letter grade means and note that the description changes **for term 3**.
