1) Welcome and opening remarks

5) Business issues:

a) Approval of Educational Project

a) Principal's Report

- Transco Bus service is back after a long strike. Parents will be receiving \$7.00/day compensation in two installments.

- Author Kaitlin Evans visited the school and met with students in grade pre-k to grade 4.
- Brain awareness from McGill University is coming on March 19th and will be making age appropriate presentations to the whole school.
- Mr. V applied for an Artists Inspire Grant and as such will have a Brazilian musician visiting.
- LDVA Storytelling will take place on March 21
- Reminder that the ped day initially scheduled to take place on March 22 has now been moved to Monday, April 8 due to the Solar Eclipse.
- LDVA has received \$16,000 for the MEQ for Rattrapage due to the teacher strike days.
 Teachers have made recommendations for students who will benefit from this extra support. Teachers on staff will be tutoring the students along with two well-known substitute teachers.
- The planning for 2024-2025 is underway.
