The administrative team at LBP would like to welcome everyone to an exciting school year, where all students will have a chance to experience personal success! Let us all work together to ensure that our students work hard, complete assigned work and experience academic and personal growth as part of their plan for success!

1. September 3-Labour Day

No classes for students. School will be closed.

2. September 4-5-6-Welcome Back Level Assemblies

All students will be invited to level assemblies to begin the school year. School policies and procedures will be reviewed with the students as well as expectations as a member of the LBP family. Secondary 1 & 2 assemblies will take place on September 4th, Secondary 3 & 4 assemblies will take place on September 5th and Secondary 5 assemblies will take place on September 6th.

3. September 7-School Fee Payment Deadline

Every student must have his or her school fees paid by today. Please be sure to have all payments in! Please understand that these fees are collected to cover the cost of school ID cards, workbooks, and agendas. All students have received them, or will be receiving them shortly. 4. September 7-ID Picture Day for New Students

Students who missed their school ID pictures on August 28th may take their picture today. The students will be called down when the photographer is ready to begin. All students are required to have a LBP ID card so ID pictures are compulsory.

5. September 10- Teacher Tutorials Begin!

Every teacher at LBP will hold tutorials for their students. The tutorial times for each teacher will be placed on our school website. We encourage all students to take advantage of these tutorials in order to ensure a successful school year. Every Teacher will post their tutorials in their classes, so look out for the information.

6. September 12- OPUS Day at LBP

The STM will be visiting LBP OPUS day. Students who need an OPUS or need to renew their existing OPUS will be able to do so on this day. All information regarding OPUS was distributed on August 28th to the students and can be found on our school website. An email was also sent to parents on August 30th, 2018. We were able to secure an earlier date for the OPUS day, but it falls on a Wednesday schedule. Students in Sport Études will have their OPUS cards done between 8:15 a.m. -9:10 a.m. to minimize class time missed. while the rest of the students will come down during the day. It is important to note that all students UNDER the age of 14 must have a parent/guardian signature on their application in order to purchase their OPUS card. The cost for the card is \$14 EXACT change **payable on OPUS day only to the STM**.

Our Governing Board is the decision-making body for our school, which is an essential group for the proper managing & functioning of our school. All parents/guardians are encouraged to be part of your child's education and be involved in our school.
