

o Take time to visit school website for the standards and procedure documents for your child's classes.





o Take time to visit the school website and read the monthly newsletter to know what is taking place at school as activities and special events.





o Take time to visit the school website and read the monthly newsletter to know what is being offered as support to our students throughout the year and during the exam periods.




In school events.

o Take time to attend school events where parents/guardians are invited to, such as Curriculum Night and Parent/Teacher Interviews.





o Cooperate with the school on the policies and procedures put forward for your child as a student at LBP.




Have faith in my child's ability.

o Believe that your child can be successful, together with support at home and at school.




