

## <u>UNIFORM</u>

Appropriate clothing and appearance is mandatory. The uniform must be worn as of the first day. All uniform garments must be purchased from the school's official supplier, **Top Marks**. Only the following items will be accepted:

- > Navy blue pants
- > Royal blue or white polo shirt short or long sleeved, collar down
- > Navy blue V-neck or zip-up sweater worn over a school polo
- Low –heeled shoes
- Only a plain short sleeved T-shirt may be worn under all tops. (no turtle-necks or long sleeves t-shirts will be permitted)
- > Graduation apparel of the current graduating year for Secondary 5 students only.

## Students are reminded that:

- > Both pants and polo's must not be rolled since this is considered altering the uniform.
- > Caps, bandanas, or any headgear are **<u>not</u>** permitted in school.
- > Non-school uniform sweaters, outdoor jackets or coats are **not** permitted in classes.
- Boots are **not** permitted on the second, third floor and sports complex area
- $\succ$  Belts must not be visible.
- > Sandals / flip flops are not acceptable.
- > Only LBP book bags are acceptable.

## Please note that students must be in full uniform coming into school, at dismissal & in order to board the Express buses.

Within the policy, there are areas that we require all parents to pay **particular attention to:** 

1) We advise parents to purchase the school sweater because during the colder weather, students will want to wear an extra layer of clothing over their school shirts. The weather cannot be used as an excuse to wear non-uniform clothing. <u>Only the school sweater is permitted.</u>

2) Students are not allowed to wear a non-uniform long-sleeved shirt under their short-sleeved polo tops. Only plain short sleeved t-shirts are permitted under the uniform tops as long as the sleeves do not show. Students are not permitted to roll up their sleeves of their uniform polos.

## 3) <u>Only uniform pants</u> supplied by Top Marks are acceptable. NO ALTERATIONS TO UNIFORM PANTS WILL BE ACCEPTED (I.E. EXTREME TIGHTENING OF THE PANTS).

N.B. Students not complying with the compulsory school uniform (approved by Governing Board) will be expected to change into acceptable school wear (provided by administration). Consequently, we will be <u>SENDING HOME</u> those students who regularly show a blatant disregard and lack of respect for the Uniform Policy.
