### **CEGEP Applications/Voc. Training/Ad. Education**

We will be meeting our secondary 5 students shortly to discuss the general application process for CEGEP, Vocational Training, and Adult Education. Important procedures and deadlines will be reviewed in order to assist our students during this important time for planning. There is no news yet whether the deadline will be extended or not. We will inform you when and if that happens.

**1.** January 8<sup>th</sup>: Pedagogical Day No classes for students.

The Guidance Counselors will be visiting classes prior to the subject selection day to prepare the students about their options. We ask that all students be present for this important process taking place during period 1. <u>If students are not returning to LBP, we ask that an email be sent to the level secretary</u> <u>advising us that your child will not be returning</u>. Forms should be returned as soon as possible following the process. The deadline for forms to be returned is January 26<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

#### 4. January 17<sup>th</sup>- Terry Fox Non-Uniform Day

The Terry Fox Committee is holding a non-uniform day to raise money for the Terry Fox Foundation. We are asking everyone to be generous to help our annual fundraising efforts for this special project we've been involved with for many years.
