NEW Subject Selection Process

Our secondary 1-4 students will be taking part in our subject selection process in preparation for our next academic year. NEW this year, students will be completing their choice of courses through Mozaik with the assistance of their parents. *For families who do not have a Mozaik account, you may create an account prior to the process taking place.*

The Guidance Counselors will be visiting classes prior to the subject selection day to prepare the students about their options. We ask that all students be present for this important process taking place during period 1. <u>If</u> students are not returning to LBP, we ask that an email be sent to the level secretary advising us that your child will not be returning.
