Dear parents,

We welcome your children back to school and we hope that you all had an enjoyable holiday with your families and friends. We along with all members of our Michelangelo International School staff wish you a **Happy New Year filled with joy, peace and good health.**

A new year brings about a fresh new start, good intentions and resolutions. Let's all work together in order to ensure a smooth, successful and safe transition back to school for our students.

- Getting **sufficient sleep** is essential for your child to function properly in school.
- A **healthy**, nutritious diet combined with outdoor play fuels the young growing body and brain.
- Please be reminded that we have a nutrition policy at our school. You can read about it in your child's agenda and review it with your child. All nuts and nut based foods (i.e. Nutella, peanut butter) are not allowed. Chocolate and chocolate covered food is also not permitted.
- Students must dress appropriately for winter with snow pants, boots, hats, gloves and scarves. Students must have a pair of shoes to wear in school.
- Also, our students are required to follow the dress code as stipulated in your child's agenda.
- Respect and good manners should always be reinforced in your child.
- Reinforce the PYP Learner Profile attributes home.
- A child needs constant **encouragement**. Success, no matter how little, should be acknowledged and celebrated.
- **Reading** in English and French should be encouraged at home. Reading with your child or reading something of your own while your child reads his/ her book (even for just a few minutes daily) values literacy and education.
- **Responsibility** can be learned from a young age. Your child can prepare his clothing for the following day, prepare his/her lunch, pack the schoolbag the night before, etc.
- Punctuality is a lifelong skill that is learned from a young age. Deadlines for assignments should be respected. Making excuses for your child will not benefit in the long run. Parents are responsible for getting their children to school on time. Entry starts at 8:50 and class begins at 9:00 sharp. It is very stressful for a child when he/she walks in late. Walking in late also disrupts the classroom routine already in place.
- *Every year, especially in the fall and winter time, we get unpleasant surprises with <u>lice</u> showing up in children's hair. We recommend that students keep their hair <u>short or tied up</u>. Young children hug each other and play in close contact with each other. Please check your child's hair as often as possible.
- EDUCATION is a **shared** responsibility between school and home. We are looking forward to working collaboratively in 2020.

REMINDER



Students who are participating in any afterschool extra-curricular activity such as SOCCER, PELO, KARATE, CHESS etc. must stay for the <u>whole session</u>. The daycare educators will not be pulling students out of their activities. If there is a change to your child's schedule, please advise the school no later than 2pm.

DAYCARE FEES

Parents of students using the Daycare services full-time (5 days per week) received letter before the holidays with the new daycare fees for the months January-May 2020 - (June will be invoiced separately with any adjustments). January fees are due on January 15th, 2020. Invoices for students using the daycare services on different schedules, less than 5 days per week, or sporadically will be sent out shortly. We also encourage parents to take advantage of using our online payment option.

*Please note that any outstanding daycare fees need to be paid to continue services in January.

<u>LUNCH SUPERVISION PROGRAM FEES FOR STUDENTS NOT</u> <u>IN DAYCARE – (GR 1-6 ONLY)</u>

Lunch Supervision Fees: (Gr 1-6 only, for students NOT using the daycare services)

If you have not made payments for the lunch supervision fees for the months <u>Sept-December 2019</u> (first installment \$131.25) which was due September 17th, 2019, you will receive a payment notice shortly.

The second installment is due as of January 15th, 2020 (second installment \$185.50).

The option of one single payment for the year is \$316.75.

Lunch fees need to be made to Michelangelo International School.

You can also take advantage of the online payment option. It is very important that online payments are made with the correct online code for lunch fees.

Please do not pay lunch supervision fees with a daycare code. They are separate accounts. Online Lunch Fees need to start with **LH CODES.
