#### **FOOTWEAR**



With the warm weather comes all different kinds of fun shoes. However, to ensure student safety, we highly recommend that students wear closed shoes (with socks) for school. Sandals without straps, especially flipflops, are not allowed as students cannot run and play without getting hurt.

#### **PROTECTION FROM THE SUN**

We encourage parents to apply sunscreen **<u>before</u>** sending their child(ren) to school. Should you wish for your child to reapply the sunscreen during the day, we strongly recommend a "sunscreen stick," since your child will need to apply it quickly and on their own to avoid missing Recess and being unsupervised in the hallway. Under no circumstances will students be allowed to share their sunscreen with a friend.

A cap, or a hat with a visor is perfect protection for the eyes. Sunglasses are not to be brought to school as they can cause accidents in the school yard.

All children should come to school with a refillable water bottle. Our water fountains are open and have a feature where students can easily fill their water bottles with cold water. We understand you may not be comfortable with your child using the school water fountain; if this is the case, we ask that you send your child to school with two water bottles especially on hot days.

# **GRADUATION**



*The Grade 6 Graduation Ceremony* will take place on *Wednesday, June 21<sup>st</sup>* at Renaissance Banquet Hall. The Grade 6 graduates have already received their invitations. The Certificate Ceremony will take place at 6:00pm. Students and staff will then celebrate together with dinner and dancing afterward the ceremony.

*The Pre-Kindergarten Celebration* will also take place on *Tuesday, June 20<sup>th</sup> at 2:00pm* in our school gymnasium. # JUNE DAYCARE NEWS

**DAYCARE WEEK:** Daycare week was a great success. The students had an amazing time enjoying all the exciting activities. We enjoyed carnival activities with face painting, snow cones, Latin dancing with Latin Dance Groove. They also had fun on the Fiesta inflatables, playing Bingo, making their own world key chains celebrating our theme a "World of Discovery".

We also had very happy tummies with all the special treats, breakfasts, the pizza truck, and the Waffle Bar. Thanking all the educators for their hard work, the children for their enthusiastic participation and the parents for their cooperation and support, and especially the special messages of encouragement. It was all very much appreciated! We are so happy to be able to fully celebrate with your children.

**JUNE DAYCARE PROGRAMS:** Your child's educator will be sending home the daycare program for June shortly. This being the last program of the school year, the educators have a lot of special activities planned. Please keep an eye on the program to see what your child's daycare group is doing!

**DAYCARE REGISTRATIONS FOR 2023-2024:** A reminder! Registrations on Mosaik for Daycare services ended April 28, 2023. Parents can **no longer** register online. If you missed the deadline and need the daycare services, please contact me by email only with all the details and we will enter the registration manually. Please note that the Mosaik registrations for Daycare was only for students who need before and after school daycare services. It was not designed for parents to register solely for lunch supervision unless your child is starting PreK or Kindergarten. These students are all under the Daycare "umbrella" and the only exception.

**Important!** Should your situation or needs change and you need to adjust your child's daycare status it is very important that you advise us before school starts on August 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Please send me a detailed email with the changes. The daycare office will be back on: **August 24<sup>th</sup>, 2023.** Since we are a government funded program; therefore, it is very important to have the correct registrations before the September 30<sup>th</sup>, <u>2023, deadline to receive the proper funding.</u>

Students starting Gr 1-6 who are not attending daycare regularly, will be part of the **school lunch supervision program**. This is simply a different budget and account, so they need to be registered separately. If your child is starting Gr 1-6 and you accidently registered for daycare lunch supervision on Mozaik, we have cancelled that registration for you. **This does not affect your school registration**.

Parents of students in Gr 1-6 not registered in daycare next year will receive information regarding the school lunch supervision fees in September 2023.

# **DAYCARE FEES & SCHOOL LUNCH SUPERVISION FEES:**

The Daycare & Lunch statements of account for May have now been emailed to all<br/>parents.They are due on May 31st, 2023.

June statements for both lunch and daycare will be sent the first week of and are due by June 15th, 2023. All balances need to be cleared at this time to close out our financial school year. Students with unpaid fees cannot attend daycare or receive lunch supervision the following year until payment is made. For students graduating and leaving the school, your balances need to be cleared.

\*All outstanding debts from students leaving the school that are not cleared will be sent to financial services at the school board for collection.

If parents have any overpaid or have credits at the end of the school year; we will either send you a reimbursement cheque for overpaid amounts or carry it over as a credit for next year if you are returning. We are waiting for further instructions from financial services at the EMSB as to how to proceed.



On behalf of the Daycare staff, we want to thank everyone for all the support, and enthusiasm throughout the school year. We wish everyone a well-deserved, safe and happy summer holiday.
