## Grade 4 IB News

### Why are certain languages more prominent around the world?

### What does it mean to live a healthy lifestyle?



# Important! Daycare Registrations 2023-2024

We have received most of the <u>Daycare 2023-2024 Pre-Registration</u> responses for students that will be in Gr 1-6 next year, as well as the returning students from PreK & Kindergarten, thank you. The deadline to register online on Mozaik was **Friday April 28, 2023.** 

If you were unable to register online on Mozaik and need the daycare services next year, you can still register with us! Please contact me by email and I will provide you with a temporary paper from registration and we will register your child manually. <u>It's very important that you are all registered on time as our services, budgets and staffing are directly affected.</u>





**Please do not register only for lunch supervision services using Mozaik.** The school lunch supervision program is a <u>separate program</u>. You will receive information for the lunch program in August 2023. If you already registered for lunch accidentally online, we will be cancelling it for you. This will not affect your school registrations.



\*Special for PreK & Kindergarten students only: students in PreK & Kindergarten are all part of the <u>daycare lunch program</u> even if you are not registering for the other daycare services. This is an exception for the younger students in our school.

\*Returning students in our PreK starting Kindergarten in August 2023 can register for daycare lunch supervision only for next year.

\*Some parents may have one child in the **daycare lunch** because they are in PreK or Kdg and another child on the **school lunch supervision program.** Parents simply need to ensure they are registered for the correct one and paying the right accounts next year. More information will be provided when school begins.

We have planned some fun activities for the daycare students for Daycare Week. Students will be treated to a breakfast every morning that week starting at: **8am-8:30am**.
