Dear parents,

We are about to begin our second month of school, and all is going well. We hope your child(ren) will continue to invest time and energy in learning new skills and concepts. Your support will be needed in ensuring that your child(ren) gets the proper rest by going to bed at a reasonable time at night. Please verify that all homework is being done properly and that your child(ren) studies and reads in English and French everyday.



Our school day begins at 8:52am. Parents are reminded to ensure that all students arrive to school on time. We are implementing proper work habits for our students and teaching them the value of being punctual. Arriving on time also sets the tone for how your child's day will go. Please be reminded that **three lates in one-month results in a reflection.**

We would also like you to remember to **keep the bus corridor free of pedestrians** to ensure that students can get off and, on the bus, safely. These measures have been put into place for the safety and security of all our students and we ask for the full cooperation of all our parents.

We also ask that parents do not block the entrance to the main gate of the school yard. Once your child(ren) enters the yard or are picked up, please keep the entrance free so that students can enter or exit without heavy congestion.

SCHOOL FEES



If you have yet to pay this year's school fees (that were due on September 10th) you are asked to do so as soon as possible. Both cash and cheques are accepted.

GOING PAPERLESS

As you have noticed we have moved into being a "paperless" community. As much as we all are accustomed to having a "paper copy" of notices, going paperless was not only safer for us all during the pandemic, but it also helps us use less paper and save the trees. It is the way of the future!



Just a reminder when accessing a Microsoft Form. If the link does not work when you click on it, copy the link, and paste it into the browser (NOT the Google search bar). Often, accessing the link on a computer works better than your cell phone.

IMPORTANT FORMS

We ask that you sign and return all forms to school with your child. These forms include: the health form, photo consent form, and registration form. We also ask that all parents of Pre-K and Kindergarten students send in a copy of their certificate of eligibility to complete your child's dossier if you have not done so already.

SCHOOL OFFICE

The school office is a very **busy place**. It is like Grand Central Station. It is where we **all** go when we need something. We ask that you keep this in mind when you call the office. The **first and last hour of the day, as well as lunch time are the busiest times**. We ask that you do not call during these times unless it is an **emergency**. Also, calling with a last-minute change to your child's dismissal plan is not possible as we cannot guarantee that your child will get the message. This causes a lot of stress to not only the office, your child's teacher, and your child. Lastly, as much as the secretaries would love to have a full conversation with you when you call, they are not able to. When you call the school, please be mindful of our wonderful secretaries and keep your call short. They are trying not to be rude, but often they are juggling your call, as well as a child asking for a band-aid or feeling sick.

Daycare News for October 2022:

The daycare educators have been introducing many new activities to help keep all the students stimulated, busy and happy. We have also received news that the B.A.S.E extracurricular activities will also begin shortly. We are very excited to re-introduce all these programs to our daycare students! Educators have all prepared October programs for their daycare groups in which parents will receive a copy.

Online Payments Reminders:

For Daycare Fees:

A reminder to use the **SG code** (service-de-garde) to pay online daycare fees only. This includes Ped days. Allow at least 24-48 hours for fees to be processed.

Please do not send cash.

The payee must be Michelangelo Daycare. The SG code is located on the statement.

For Daycare Lunch Supervision Fees: (Pre-k & Kdg)

Same online codes as above apply (SG code).



Online Payments for Non-Daycare students for Lunch Supervision fees:

This option is only to pay for lunch supervision fees.

Code starts with **LH (lunch hour)**

Please don't use the online payment for any other school fees.

It is only set up for lunch fees.

Parents who received a letter regarding the school lunch supervision fees need to pay fees to this account.

***Special Note:** Please pay careful attention to the statement of account you receive by email; it will indicate if it is from Daycare or the School lunch supervision program. Some parents have children in each program; therefore, it is very important it is paid to the correct program as it not transferable.

October Ped Days:

Monday, October 3, 2022 – In school activities – World Smile Day

***Letters for this Ped day have already gone out to parents and the deadline to register was September 27, 2022.**

This Ped day is also on Election Day, and since our school is a polling station, the daycare entrance will be closed off. **Students registered for this ped day need to be dropped off and picked up at the office doors for this ped day only.*

Letters regarding our upcoming Ped Days will be sent out shortly to all parents by email and regular daycare students received a paper copy as well. We cannot accept any late registrations for Ped days since we staff, schedule order materials, snacks and plan according to the number of registrations we receive. Please respect the deadlines. A reminder to parents, we have only **one entry and pick up door** which is the main daycare door (near the gym).

All students from Pre-k to Gr 6 attending a ped day need to use this door.

***Deadline for the Oct 14, 2022 Ped day is: Friday October 7th, 2022.**

***Deadline for the Oct. 19, 2022 Ped day is: Wednesday October 12, 2022**



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CHANGE OF DISMISSAL PROCEDURES:

Dismissal time is a very important time and critical time for the school to dismiss students safely.

Often, we receive messages of dismissal changes that are late or unclear. If your child is changing their dismissal procedure, please be very clear on the directives. For example, "*picked up*" by grandfather today needs to be clarified – is it pick up afterschool by grandfather (no daycare) or picked up by grandfather from daycare. A reminder that the deadline to call the school dismissal changes is 2pm to assure your child is dismissed safely.

AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES:

Examples: KARATE/PELO/SOCCER/CHESS



Please note that if your child is signed up for afterschool activities, he/she must **remain for the entire duration of the class**. Students will not be permitted to leave early unless parents have already called the school before **2:00 pm** to make other arrangements. Please do not ask the Daycare educators to get your students out from the activities. We will not be taking the students out of their activity. This is very disruptive for the instructors / teachers of these activities or classes, the students, as well as the Daycare. We are also unable to contact the children as they are not with the daycare during the activities.

For students who are **not in daycare** – the pick-up area after the activities is at the Schoolyard door exit (where the walkers are normally dismissed) except for Soccer which will be dismissed at the office door.

Daycare students who are participating in these afterschool activities need to be picked up no earlier than 5pm. Your children are still in their activity and have not yet returned to daycare. Please do not signal the **HOP-HOP APP** to prepare your children before 5pm as well on those days. Please advise anyone who is picking up your children of these procedures.

We are looking forward to an exciting month of activities in Daycare!
