### Dear parents,

We are about to begin our second month of school and we hope your child(ren) will continue to invest time and energy in learning new skills and concepts. Your support will be needed in ensuring that your child(ren) gets the proper rest by going to bed at a reasonable time at night. Please verify that all homework is being done properly and that your child(ren) studies and reads in English and French everyday.

### **LATES**



Our school day begins at 8:52am. Parents are reminded to ensure that all students arrive to school on time. We are implementing proper work habits for our students and teaching them the value of being punctual. Arriving on time also sets the tone for how your child's day will go.

### A.M ENTRY/ P.M DISMISSAL

We would also like to remind you to keep the bus corridor free of pedestrians to ensure that students can get off and, on the bus, safely. These measures have been put into place for the safety and security of all our students and we ask for the full cooperation of all our parents.

We also ask that parents do not block the entrance to the main gate of the school yard. Once your child(ren) enters the yard or are picked up at the end of the day, please keep the entrance free so that students can enter or exit without heavy congestion.

#### **SCHOOL FEES**



If you have yet to pay this year's school fees (that were due on September 10<sup>th</sup>) you are asked to do so as soon as possible. Both cash and cheques are accepted.

### **SCHOOL UNIFORM**

Please note that if a student wears tights to school, they must wear a top that **covers their bottom.**

### **IMPORTANT FORMS**



We ask that you sign and return all forms to school with your child. These forms include: the health form, photo consent form, and registration form. We also ask that all parents of Pre-K and Kindergarten students send in a copy of their certificate of eligibility to complete your child's dossier if you have not done so already.

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### **SCHOOL OFFICE**

The school office is a very **busy place**. It is where we **all** go when we need something. We ask that you keep this in mind when you call the office. The **first and last hour of the day, as well as lunch** 

time are the busiest times. We ask that you do not call during these times unless it is an emergency. Also, calling with a last-minute change to your child's dismissal plan is not encouraged as we cannot guarantee that your child will get the message. This causes a lot of stress at the office, to your child's teacher, and to your child. When calling the school, please be mindful that our secretaries are juggling many things at once and are therefore

unable to have long conversations with each parent. It is important to keep calls short so that they have the time to properly attend to everyone's concerns.

### **IB HIGHLIGHT**

**Express yourself!** The Grade 5 students spent the first few weeks of the school year learning about how communication brings about understanding. They have been exploring the many ways people communicate, how different cultural and personal elements influence communication and finally how communication has evolved and changed though time.

In French class, the students' curiosity was piqued when they had the opportunity to view an assortment of communication used through time. They were also very engaged when learning about the science of sound.

# **Daycare News for October 2023:**

The daycare educators have been introducing many new activities to help keep all the students stimulated, busy and happy. We will also receive new B.A.S.E extracurricular activities which will also begin shortly. We are very excited to introduce all these programs to our daycare students! Educators have all prepared October programs for their daycare groups in which parents will receive a copy.

### **Online Payments Reminders:**

### For Daycare Fees:

A reminder to use the *SG code* (service-de-garde) to pay online daycare fees only.

This includes Ped days. Allow at least 48-72 hours for fees to be processed.

#### Please do not send cash.

The payee must be Michelangelo Daycare. The SG code is located on the statement.

### For Daycare Lunch Supervision Fees: (Pre-k & Kdq)

Same online codes as above apply (SG code).

# Online Payments for Non-Daycare students for Lunch Supervision fees: This option is only to pay for lunch supervision fees.

Code starts with *LH (lunch hour)* 

Please don't use the online payment for any other school fees.

It is only set up for lunch fees.

Parents who received a letter regarding the school lunch supervision fees need to pay fees to this account.

\*<u>Special Note</u>: Please pay careful attention to the statement of account you receive by email; it will indicate if it is from Daycare or the School lunch supervision program. Some parents have children in both programs; therefore, it is very important it is paid to the correct program as it not transferable.

# October Ped Days:

- Friday, October 13, 2022 In school activities Fall Harvest \*Letters for this Ped day have already gone out to parents.
  Deadline to register is October 2, 2023.
- Wednesday, October 18, 2022 In school activities Halloween Fun \*Letters for this Ped day will be sent out shortly. Deadline to register will be October 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023.



Letters regarding all future Ped Days will be sent out to all parents with children attending Michelangelo School. You will receive them by email. Regular daycare students will also receive a paper copy. To register for Ped days, your child needs to be registered with daycare as a sporadic user (if you are not already registered). Please contact the daycare office if you need to register your child. Important! Please note that we cannot accept any late registrations for Ped days since we staff, schedule, order materials, snacks, and plan according to the number of registrations we receive. Please respect the deadlines. We cannot make exceptions. A reminder to parents that we use the daycare door for entry and dismissal on Ped days.

### **CHANGE OF DISMISSMAL:**

Dismissal time is a very important time and critical time for the school to dismiss students safely. Often, we receive messages of dismissal changes that are late or unclear. If your child is changing their dismissal procedure, please be very clear on the directives.

For example, "picked up" by grandfather today needs to be clarified – is it pick up afterschool by grandfather (no daycare) or picked up by grandfather (from daycare). A reminder that the deadline to call the school for dismissal changes is 2pm to assure your child is dismissed safely.

## **Daycare Pick-up Afterschool:**

To ensure the student's safety, it is very important that safety measures are always followed. We ask for parents support and cooperation with the following safety measures:

- Please make sure to make yourself visible at the door when picking up your child and announce who you are there to pick up
- 4 Children will not be dismissed if you are not physically present (please do not wait in your car)
- Advise the daycare if someone other than those authorized will be picking up your child (a written email is preferable) without authorization we cannot dismiss your child
- Advise any adult picking up your child (including parents themselves) that daycare staff may ask for verification or ID

\*Often, we have different daycare staff answering the door who may not know or recognize the adult; therefore, verification is required. We ask for your patience and support during this time as we have hundreds of students in daycare to dismiss safely every evening.

# **AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES:**

# **Examples: KARATE/PELO/CHESS**



Please note that if your child is signed up for afterschool activities, he/she must <u>remain for the entire</u> <u>duration of the class</u>. Students will not be permitted to leave early unless parents have already called the school before <u>2:00 pm</u> to make other arrangements. Please do not ask the Daycare educators to get your students out from the activities. We will not be taking the students out of their activity. This is very disruptive for the instructors / teachers of these activities or classes, the students, as well as the Daycare. We are also unable to contact the children as they are not with the daycare during the activities.

For students who are <u>not in daycare</u> – the pick-up area after the activities is at the <u>Schoolyard door exit</u> (where the walkers are normally dismissed).

<u>Daycare students</u> who are participating in these afterschool activities need to be picked up no earlier than 5:10pm. Your children are still in their activity and have not yet returned to daycare. Please do not signal the **HOP-HOP APP** to prepare your children before 5:10pm as well on those days. Please advise anyone who is picking up your children of these procedures.
