Dear Parents,

We are happy to greet our new and returning students for the 2023-2024 academic school year. We would like to take this opportunity to wish everyone a successful school year.



WELCOMING DAY

Friday, September 15th, will be our official welcoming day. Numerous fun activities have been planned for the students to make their back to school as fun as ever.

SCHOOL PHOTOS

Our school photos will take place on October 12th, 2023. Please note that sibling photos will not be possible this year as the company is not offering this service. We are already looking into the matter for next year.

School uniform is mandatory for the school photos.

DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

Dismissal for PK and K students will take place at 3:47pm. Dismissal for grades 1-6 will take place every day at 3:52 p.m. No student will be allowed to be removed from the bus by any adult other than a staff member. Please do not change your child's routine without written notification. Calling at the last minute (after noon on the day of) cannot guarantee that your child will receive the correct message in a timely manner. Please help us avoid a dangerous situation by writing in your child's agenda any changes made to your child's daily routine.

*Please note that as of September 5th, pre-kindergarten and kindergarten parents can no longer enter the school yard to pick up their child.

STUDENT DISMISSAL

To ensure a safe and secure learning environment for all our students, please take note of the rules regarding student drop off and pick up.

- No parents are allowed in the school yard at any time: Parents picking up their children must wait at the gate. Please do not block the gate entrance as the students need to have a clear path to leave the yard.
- Using the daycare door: Only students who are boarding the busses at the end of the day are to exit from the daycare door. This is necessary to alleviate the congested sidewalk traffic and to ensure the safe boarding of the buses by all the students in a timely manner.
- Please do not pick up your child at the daycare door before ALL busses are gone. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.
- School buses: Please do not use the sidewalk while students are boarding the school buses. Kindly wait until the buses have departed to cross the school bus loading area to access the school yard gates where students are dismissed. Reminder that it is against the law to pass a school bus when the flashing red lights and/or STOP sign are activated. The penalty is a fine and demerit points.

Our children's safety is our 1st priority.

DROP OFF ZONE/NO PARKING ZONE/NO STOPPING ZONES(S) REMINDER

Please note that the section of the street that runs all along the front side of the school yard is designated as a bus drop off zone during morning arrival. Parking in the drop off zone forces a slowdown in traffic, and forces other parents to drop off their child in the middle of the street. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.

MORNING LATE ENTRANCE

Michelangelo International Daycare service is available from 7:00 a.m.

The school bell rings at 8:47 a.m and the second bell rings at 8:52 a.m. Since it is important for children to learn the value of being punctual, therefore, students are expected to be at school on time to allow for the smooth running of their day and to avoid class disruptions.

Please note that no students will be admitted via the front door unless a student is late, where the secretary will therefore administer a late slip.





Please remember that parents can now enter their child(ren)'s absence(s) on the Mozaik portal instead of calling the school.

MORNING ENTRANCE

All students, grades PK-6, must enter the school by one of the four entrances mentioned below.

- ENTRANCE 1 (Daycare Doors)
 - o For bus students & daycare drop-offs
- **ENTRANCE 4** (Kindergarten Doors)
 - o For Pre-K and Kindergarten students
- **ENTRANCE 3** (Regular school entrance via schoolyard)
 - o For grades 1 and 2
- ENTRANCE 5 (Back school yard Doors)
 - o Grades 3, 4, 5 and 6





SCHOOL LUNCH DELIVERIES

Students should come to school every day with a **healthy** and **nut free lunch** that includes a beverage and snack. Our hot meal provider is Le Doral. **Please understand that we do not accept daily deliveries from parents.** This includes parents delivering daily lunches to the office or using Uber Eats to send food to school for their child. This is very disruptive to the school routine and that of your child. Therefore, make sure your child leaves home with his lunch and snack for the day. Please take note that we do not have a cafeteria and we do not have extra hot lunches; thus, it is entirely the responsibility of the parents to ensure that their children have a lunch and snack.

REFLECTIONS

As per school protocol, teachers, supervisors and administration issue a reflection when a student behaves in a way that requires them to think about their actions. The purpose of a reflection is not to punish a student, rather it provides for an opportunity for students to reflect on their actions, and what they can do differently in the future when faced with a similar situation. As per our mandate, it is our responsibly to educate students both academically & socially.

ORIENTATION NIGHT

We held our orientation on August 28th and once again it was a success! We hope you enjoyed meeting your child(ren)'s teachers.

REMIND APP

To help facilitate keeping on top of everyone's busy schedules, we are using the Remind app to keep you up to date concerning important upcoming events, and to send you pictures and clips of your children.

Please note that this app is a **one-way communication**. You can send us an email or place a phone call for any concerns or issues pertaining to your child. We already sent a memo on how to sign up. Please make sure to sign up according to your child's grade level. Your child's teacher(s) may will also have their own Remind App and they will send you the information so you can see what is taking place in their specific classroom.

Remember, when posting on social media, we try to keep our written messages as short as possible. We also like to post pictures and/or videos, however, understand that we can't post everything from one event.



WHAT IS STEAM IN SCHOOLS?

I am happy to be back ready and eager to get started on all the exciting activities planned for the students attending daycare this year. Daycare students will receive a healthy snack afterschool every day as of September 11th, 2023; until then please provide an extra snack for your child.

ENTRY & DISMISSAL FOR DAYCARE

PreK & Kindergarten students starting daycare on September 5th, 2023 will use the regular daycare entrance/exit next to the office located on 5e rue.

Important: Parents or anyone coming to pick up or drop students in daycare will not be permitted to enter the school.

SCHOOL LUNCH SUPERVISION PROGRAM (students not in daycare — Gr 1-6 only)

For students in Gr 1-6 who are **NOT** using the daycare services:

Parents received a letter regarding lunch supervision fees in June 2023.

The cost for lunch supervision is \$2.25/day. Statements will be sent out monthly via email.

For students who are not in daycare need to pay the school for lunch supervision fees to the school by cheque or through online banking. The online code is in indicated on your statements starting with an LHCODE to Michelangelo School as your payee.

Please make sure to bring utensils and water bottles every day for lunch.

A MESSAGE FROM THE NURSE



ALLERGY-EPIPEN-SCHOOL NEW INFO

Teaching your child about food allergies is an important part of keeping them safe. Young children can start to learn about food allergies at a young age. This knowledge will give them confidence with self-managing their food allergies as they get older.

Taking in consideration the recommendation of the new allergy guide there will be some new guidelines to follow at school:

In each classroom there will be an envelope with the student's name, picture, allergy, and placement of the EpiPen. In this envelope school staff will find a personalised intervention plan for each student and step by step administration protocol.

GRADE 1-6

- In your school, the student will always keep the EpiPen on themselves except gym class. It is important for the student to have a belt bag or fanny pack for easy access for school staff in case of an emergency. We need your help to teach your child at home to ask for help from an adult if not feeling well and to never open the medication by themselves, to show a friend or to play with it.

PRE-K KDG

- Considering the young age of the children and following the allergy guide, for Pre-K and KDG students the EpiPen will be kept in unlocked classroom on the wall for easy access.

GYM CLASS

- In the gymnasium, a special board with hooks will be available so the student can place their belt bag in a safe place while doing exercise.

BELTBAG or FANNY PACK

- Take some time to talk with your child about his or her allergy. Choose the belt bag together, you can personalise it too. On the Epipen.ca website you can order one too if needed.



REMEMBER:

Never share food, wash your hands before and after eating, use a placemat, tell a Grown up if you are not feeling well

To ease this transition, the school nurse will make a class tour with her puppet named EPI to inform ALL the children.
