## 8.5 Business Arising – May 25th, 2023

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

## Playground & garden

- MEQ has allotted \$20,427 to PDC and this amount is not necessary to use in the yard this school year. 80 % of the spendings is paid by the ministry and the remaining 20% is paid by the school.
- We have \$7400 that was provided by MR(Maintenance Resource) and we spend \$5000
- We raised \$12,600 for the playground subtracting \$2,400.
- \$5, 106.95 was used to buy two outdoor, octagonal, weather resistant picnic tables for the students.
- Adamo requested the amount of \$800 from the playground budget to have a truck to come to remove the remaining earth and debris from the garden area.
- Work in the garden area will continue during the summer.
- The kindergarten playground platform will be extended.
- New and additional apparatus' will be assembled and installed before the new school year.
- Maria Corsi asked how long we could keep the money given to us by the ministry and Ida mentioned that we could keep it for 2 years.
- \$10 000 that was raised for the playground is currently in Fund 3
- Tania Decobellis asked that we not use that \$10 000 for anything but the playground project.
- Maria Corsi moved to approve the playground and garden project
- Adamo Di Lembo seconded the motion

#### 8.6 Annual Budget

- Ida Pisano discussed the prediction of the Annual budget for the 2023-2024 school year.
- \$83,054 is the amount that will rolled over to the next school year.
- Adamo Di Lembo asked that if we could have a more details pertaining to Fund 3 and its rollover for the following year.

# 8.7 High School Exam – Preparatory Courses

- The cost for this preparatory class is \$260 for 5 sessions of instruction.
