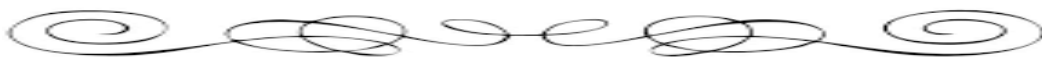
Dear Parents,

## **Threatening Food Allergies**

### **Absences**

If your child is absent on a given day, please make sure to use the Mozaik app to declare the absence. If you call, prior to 8:00 am, please leave a message indicating your child's name, class number, and the reason for the absence.

### **Bussing**

If your child is entitled to bussing, you should have received the bus pass in the mail sent by the Transportation department at the EMSB. If your child receives accommodation bussing, the school secretaires have called you to pick up your bus pass at school.

### **Safety**

Parents are asked not to use the school parking lot to drop off or pick up their children or for any other reason. The school parking lot is reserved for the school staff only.

### **Parking—Bus Zones**

The last thing that anyone needs is a parking ticket. Please do not park in the Bus Zone on Valery Street. The area is restricted for busses only.

### **Parent Information Evening – Standards and Procedures**

On Thursday, September 21st, the staff at Pierre de Coubertin School will be having an Information Evening. On this occasion, parents from Cycle 1 to Cycle 3 will meet with their child's teachers to receive important information regarding the competencies that will be targeted for the year, homework assignments, classroom rules and practices. Please make a special effort to attend this evening because you play an important role in cooperating with the school in your child's success. This information session is not meant to be used for personal interviews. We will let you know soon if this session will take place virtually or in person.

## **Arrival and Dismissal of Students:**

We will have staggered school hours to avoid congestion during entry.

Please follow the schedule below:

### **Morning Arrival:**

- Daycare students will be brought to their class at 8:35am.
- Bus students will arrive at 8:40am. They will disembark and go to their class.
- Walkers will arrive at 8:45am and enter the school on a free entry basis. They will be allowed to enter the school yard as of 8:45am.
  - Grades 1-2-3 will enter the school from the JR door through the park gate entrance.
  - Grades 4-5-6 will enter via the main gate and proceed to the SR entrance - day care entrance.
  - K001-002-003 classes will enter via the kindergarten yard at 8:45 a.m.
  - K004 will enter via the park gate entrance and meet their teacher at the new wing door.
  - K4(prek) classes will enter the main gate and line up under the shelter at 8:50 a.m.

We will have staff members on duty till 8:50am to monitor the students' arrival. We ask all parents to respect these times. If your child arrives after 8:50am, please use the front entrance.

**Dismissal:**

All students will be dismissed at 3:51pm.

- Grades 1-2-3 walkers, will exit from the park gate
- Grades 4-5-6 walkers will exit from the main gate.
- K4(Pre-k) and K5 will use the doors leading to kindergarten yard. Details will follow when you meet the teachers on August 30, August 31 or September 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Closed Classes: information will be given to parents during your set meeting time on August 30, August 31 or September 1st.

**School Uniform**

At PDC, we have a dress code where students must wear blue pants / skirts and a white top with no logo. If your child requires to wear an indoor sweater, kindly have them wear the school cardigan. The phys ed uniform must be worn on phys ed days by all students in grades 1-6. Girls must not wear leggings as school pants.

**School Bus**

In the afternoon, attendance is taken for the students taking the bus. If there is a change in your child's dismissal schedule and your child will not be taking the bus on a particular day, please make sure to write a note in the agenda advising the office that your child will not be taking the bus. We need your cooperation in this matter. If there are changes to your child's dismissal, please make sure to call the school prior to 3:00 pm. We will not make changes after that time.

All students who are eligible for busing received an email from the transportation department. Your child may board the bus by showing the driver a copy of the email. When we receive the bus passes, the school secretaries will call you.

**Lunch Time**

All students will be having lunch in their classroom. Please supply a *cloth place mat* for lunch. The mat will be returned home daily. If a parent is picking up their child for lunch, it is imperative that a note is written in the agenda stating so.
