### 8. Reports

#### 8.1 Principal

- Ms. Ancona wants to thank PPO for the thoughtful gesture for Staff Appreciation Week, a lunch from Victoria's.
- PPO members were given presents for Volunteer Appreciation Week.
- We are planning a Digital Citizenship workshop for Cycle 3 students. There will be 3 sessions.
- We had our Anti-bullying Presentation with DJ Malik for Grades 1 to 6.
- Pet Therapy: I've expressed interest for the school and asked the school board to obtain funds for the Pet Therapy program. This will be to help children with anxiety, hyperactivity, etc. They would come once a week for an entire day, for all classes on a rotational schedule. Parental consent must be obtained, but this does not appear to be a problem.
- We are looking to redo gym floor and maybe classrooms' and corridors' floors. Consultation with the school board, to commence in 2023-2024 during summer.



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- Wish list; schoolyards and library.
- Paint the entire school, conversion of the computer lab into a maker space. It's a room with tables with wheels, which allows the flexibility of doing everything in one room, without only making it about technology.
- Enrollment forecast for 2022-2023: we have a total of 204 students, homerooms went from 12 to 13; 1 Pre-K class, 2 K classes, 2 Grade 1 classes, 2 Grade 2 classes, 1 Grade 3, 4, 5, and 6 classes with two split groups 3/4C and 5/6C.

- Pre-K, K, and Cycle 1 went to the Botanical Gardens & Insectarium.
- Social Solar System workshops for Kindergarten are being done now by Ms. Regina, it's going well.

# 8.3 Daycare
