Elementary schools students will be receiving weekly communications and educational plans from their teachers until the end of the school year.

Online learning during school closure

The lessons and activities in this phase will be communicated to the students in the form of online teaching, email or phone calls when necessary. School teams will communicate with parents of students who were having difficulties to encourage and support them in their distance learning. Although the learning activities remain optional, students who were failing are highly encouraged to submit their work and assignments. This will give them the opportunity to improve their learning outcomes.

Report Card

The Ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement Supérieur (MEES) has mandated Quebec schools to provide opportunities for students to consolidate the learning that was covered until the school closures. The ministry has asked teachers to use their professional judgment when reporting on the student's final mark of the year. This final mark will consider the first two terms, the evaluations that occurred before March 13 and any work submitted by students since then.
