Cycle and Level Taught:	Cycle 2 and 3, Grade 3 to 6
School Year:	2023-2024

**Program Description:** Students will work on cycle 2 and 3 academic topics, modified to the Individual student's needs (IEP). Improving communication, social behavior, emotional and sensory-motor skills are also a focus of the class. Brigance Assessment Inventory Assessment may be used to determine what students can or cannot do.

**Term 1 & 2 (30%); Term 3 (40%)**

### Competencies Targeted

#### English Language Arts:

- To read and listen to literary, popular and information-based texts
- To write self-expressive, narrative and information-based texts
- To represent her/his literacy in different media
- To use language to communicate and learn

#### Français, langue seconde – Programme de base:

- Interagir en français en se familiarisant avec le monde francophone.
- Produire des textes varies

#### Mathematics:

Students explore arithmetic, statistics, probability, measurement and geometry to meet the following mathematical competencies:

- To solve a situational problem
- To communicate by using mathematical language

Students will explore the following competencies:

- To understand the organization of a society and its territory
- To interpret change in a society and its territory
- To be open to the diversity of societies and their territories.

Students explore the following competencies:

- To understand life situation with a view to constructing a moral frame of reference.
- To take an enlighten position on situations involving a moral issue.
- To engage in moral dialogue
- To act in an appropriate manner with regard to religious phenomena

- Social behaviour, sensory- motor skills and social emotional education are not evaluated to determine final marks.
- The primary education goals for each students will be according to students Individual Education Plan (IEP).
- Partial or full integration into a regular classroom may be possible as the student develops the necessary skills.
