  - 5.1 Principal's report

#### Silvana Crigna:

• Virtual Learning: sessions were successful, reminder that presence is mandatory and attendance will be taken at the beginning of the class.

- Return to school is going well, additional safety measures and requirements for face coverings are put in place with the exception of pre-k and kindergarten: Grade 1 to 4: face covering is mandatory during transition inside building; Grade 5-6 face covering is mandatory during transition and class; staggered recess is kept in place. Since face coverings are permitted for elementary schools, no procedure mask are provided by government.
- Mandatory attendance is expected during the pandemic. The only other options are home schooling or EMSB virtual schooling provided a medical note is presented to the board for approval of exemption.
- Teacher will provide work only if a child is sick or if Santé Publique orders confinement while awaiting test results
- Report cards: report cards will not be extended and will be ready by January 22nd and accessible through Mosaic
- Air purifiers are being installed, 27 units have been confirmed
- New bathroom is open and being used by students
- Electrical panel was upgraded during the December break
- Budget spending: Request for tutors was made for the remainder of the year, improvement
  for the playground, materials and supplies for physical education and pre-k class, new
  budget received towards supporting students, breakfast program cannot be held so it will
  be replaced by snack program to compliment milk distribution.

Tanya Macdonald: Can parents provide procedural mask?

Silvana Crigna: they can wear it if parents wants to provide a procedure mask

# 5.2 Commissioner's report

#### Joseph Lalla:

- Official elections were held on November 1st. Joseph Lalla was acclaimed for 3rd term for NDG and Montreal West.
- On November 11th trusteeship expired and the first commissioner's meeting took place
- Judicial cases still in place Bill 21 case was heard in November. Bill 40 case injunction
  was granted so bill 40 does not apply to English School boards Court case bill 40 will
  begin in April.
- November 30<sup>th</sup> air purifier acquirement was discussed and approved: 800 for 30 schools for 2 million provided by the school board as government does not subsidize it.
- Interim Director General appointed as Russel Copeman,
- EMSB had the highest success rate out of all public school boards in the province
- December 16<sup>th</sup> motion introduced by Mr Lalla unanimously supporting webcasting special meetings. Public will be able to see special meetings.

#### 7. New Business

7.1 Budget building process

Review of the budget building process 2021-2022

The Central Management Advisory Committee (CMAC /RAC) in which school administrators serve, asks the Governing Board to identify the services needed by the school, budget priority for the school and make recommendations, we are in the consultation period.

Parameters established and recommendations for each and every school must be outlined in order to be put forward and assure that the schools operate within the budget while meeting the needs of the school.

# **Discussion Budget Priorities**

<u>Silvana Crigna</u>: Increase the Special Education Attendants and technicians (A & T) allocation, include all difficulty codes in the allocation formula. As comments, we should mention that the rollovers would allow to build a program. More opportunity for budget rollovers to occur to allow schools a chance to accumulate funds for programs; keeping staff assistance with minimum 50% release if no vice-principal.

Leighton Jacobs: Gym upgrade

Joseph Lalla: agrees with Silvana Crigna

Silvana Crigna: Building, gym upgrade and repairs, replacement of ceiling tiles in the corridor,

new bathroom for junior side, junior yard ground improvement,

Jesse Corbeil: lockers issues last year should be reconsidered

Silvana Crigna: it can be added to the list

Cynthia Di Renzo: lockers do need an improvement: rust, no lock, jagged, but junior bathroom and gym should be priorities, should be adapted to the children using the facilities (age\height appropriate)

Leighton Jacobs: gym should include a new floor

Silvana Crigna: yes including stage area doors to divide the gym

<u>Tanya MacDonald</u>: building improvement allocation, documentation technicians, will be on the list, attendant and technicians allocation gym upgrade ceiling tiles in the corridors, junior side bathrooms, junior yard ground improvement, lockers will be put aside for now

Documentation Technicians: put the waiting under budget priorities instead of guided principal, Secretary and Vice Principal allocation will be put instead on the budget priorities.
