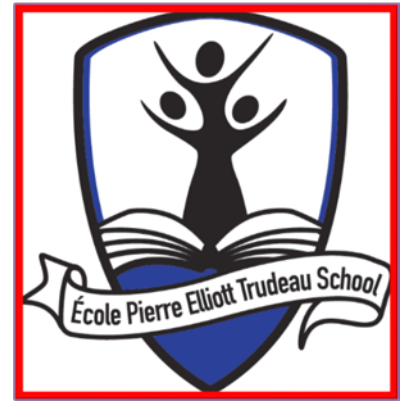

- If your child will be **absent, please call the school** before 8:30am.

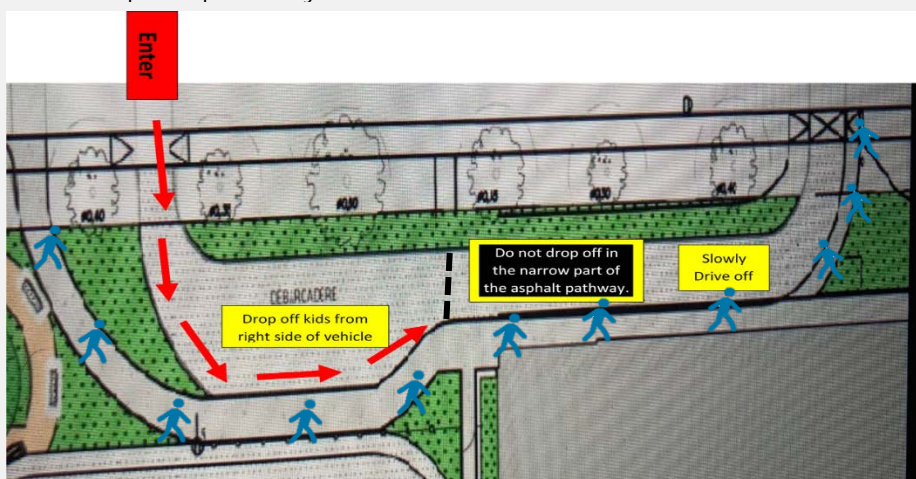
Rapid Testing has begun. If a student arrives at school showing symptoms, the student will be kept in the isolation room and will need to be picked up asap. If a student develops symptoms at school and a consent for testing was obtained, a test will be administered. If consent was not obtained, the child will remain in the isolation room and will need to be picked up asap.

Covid Vaccinations: consent forms are being collected, should you accept or decline, Once we receive more information regarding the date and location, we will inform you. Parents will not be able to be present. Should you wish to be present with your child for the vaccination, you will need to book your own appointment at a vaccination center.

Pick up & Drop Off

We ask that once your child has been picked up that you leave the school grounds and maintain social distancing. We are working very hard in ensuring everyone's safety.

Please use the débarcadère from rue Chabot to drop off and pick up students. Please use the diagram below for how vehicles should enter the débarcadère. Use the sidewalk to walk from rue Chabot and avoid walking on the asphalt pathway.

LEARN Quebec Free Online Tutoring

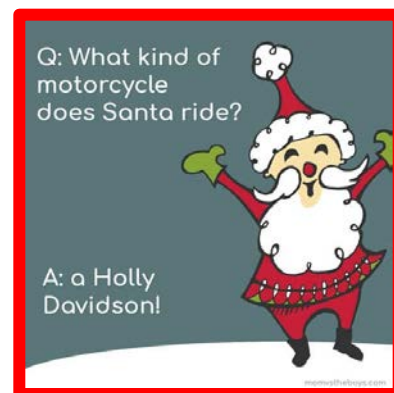
