- Parents should not be dropping off on rue Cartier unless late (after 7:35am).


LEARN Quebec Free Online Tutoring

Health & Safety

- Wash hands frequently. *"Twinkle, twinkle little star, look how clean my two hands are!"*
- Keep their distance
- The school will be providing 2 procedural masks per day to all students Grades 1 to 6. **Students are expected to wear only those and will no longer be permitted to wear face coverings.**
- Students in Grades 1 to 6 must wear a procedural mask when entering the building.
- Mandatory for students in Grades 1 & 6 to wear the masks all day, except when eating, in classrooms, common spaces and on the bus.
- *Please note that preschool students (K4 and K5) are not required to wear procedural masks in school.*
- **Due to COVID, we are asking that parents do not send in gifts for their child's classmates. This means no food, no toys, etc. We are trying very hard to keep everyone safe and thank you for your collaboration!**

COVID updates

I ask that you continue to **assess your child's health on a daily basis and inform the school if your child is symptomatic.** **Should your child be tested as positive for Covid, please inform the school IMMEDIATELY. If this should happen at night or on the weekend, please email petrudeau@emsb.qc.ca**

In accordance with the most recent guidelines from *Public Health*, individuals exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms (✓) are requested to go/stay home:

For children 6 and over AND adults:

Group A

- fever
- cough
- shortness of breath
- sudden loss of sense of smell or taste
- sore throat
- congestion or runny nose

If 1 symptom,
testing is
recommended

Group B

- intense fatigue
- significant loss of appetite
- generalized muscle pain
- nausea or vomiting
- diarrhea
- abdominal pain
- headache (unusual)

If 2 symptoms,
testing is
recommended

For children 5 and under: **Testing is recommended if any of the following:**


- Fever, rectal: 38.5 ° C (101.3° F) /oral: 38.1 ° C (100.6° F)
- Cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Runny nose, congestion or sore throat **AND** fever
- Stomach ache, vomiting or diarrhea **AND** fever

- Sibling of a student who is showing symptoms of COVID-19*

*All other household members must also self-isolate while waiting for testing and results.

Instructions:

- It is strongly recommended to get tested at the onset of symptoms (1 symptom from group A or 2 symptoms from group B),
- The student and the other household members have to self-isolate while awaiting result,
- If result is negative, the siblings can return to school immediately while the student must wait until he feels better,
- If testing is positive, the student must self-isolate for 10 days from first day symptoms appeared AND until they have completely disappeared (except for cough or loss of smell). All household members must also self-isolate (duration to be confirmed by Public Health),
- If testing is refused, the individual has to isolate (preventive isolation) for 10 days after onset of symptoms. The other household members must stay in isolation for at least 14 days after the child develops symptoms.

- Communicate with the school administration and inform him of the evolution of the situation.

Reminders

- Inform the school of **any changes to your phone number, home address or email address.**

- **Please ensure that your child has all their items before the leave for school. If an item is forgotten, unless it is essential (student lunchbox), please refrain from dropping it off at the school.**

PICK UP & DROP OFF

We ask that when you drop off your child, **please wait** until they enter the building before you leave.

We also ask that once your child has been picked up that you leave the school grounds and maintain social distancing. We are working very hard to ensure everyone's safety. If you have a dog with you, please ensure that the dog is on a leash. Keep in mind that the school yard is where our students play during recesses, so we ask that it is kept clean. Please help us to keep our children's environment clean.

Please do not park on school grounds. Use the sidewalk to enter the school parking lot and avoid walking on the asphalt pathway. There is also an entrance to the schoolyard on rue Bélanger.

Please walk your child to the gate when dropping off so that you ensure your child's safety when crossing the bike path and parking lot.
