Transportation News

The Transportation Division at the EMSB has informed us that in the upcoming weeks, they might receive notifications of cancelled bus services at the last minute, due in part to Santé Publique's new directives, asking people to remain in isolation, not only when they have symptoms of Covid-19, but also when a member of the family bubble has symptoms, and is waiting for results. This has raised major concerns for the transportation companies as they now have more and more bus drivers being asked to self-isolate, creating an even bigger shortage of bus drivers. If this affects your child(ren)'s bus, the EMSB's Transportation division will send you a voice and email notification via School Messenger. If your child(ren)'s bus is cancelled, you must kindly make arrangements to drop them off and to pick them up from the school. Health & Safety

- Wash hands frequently. "Twinkle, twinkle little star, look how clean my two hands are!"
- Keep their distance
- Wear a face mask (mandatory for Grades 1 to 6) when entering the building.
- The school will be providing 2 procedural masks per day to all students Grades 1 to 6.
 From the moment the masks arrive, students will be expected to wear only those and will no longer be permitted to wear face coverings.
- Mandatory for students in Grades 1 & 6 to wear the masks all day, except when eating, in classrooms, common spaces and on the bus.
- Please note that preschool students (K4 and K5) are not required to wear procedural masks in school.

COVID updates

*All other household members must also self-isolate while waiting for testing and results.

Instructions:

- It is strongly recommended to get tested at the onset of symptoms (1 symptom from group A or 2 symptoms from group B),
- The student and the other household members have to self-isolate while awaiting result,
- If result is <u>negative</u>, the siblings can return to school immediately while the student must wait until he feels better,
- If testing is <u>positive</u>, the student must self-isolate for 10 days from first day symptoms appeared AND until they have completely disappeared (except for cough or loss of smell). All household members must also self-isolate (duration to be confirmed by Public Health),
- If testing is <u>refused</u>, the student has to self-isolate for 10 days from first day symptoms appeared AND until they have completely disappeared,

- Communicate with the school administration and inform him of the evolution of the situation.
